Prof. C H Kabir

Prof. Dr. Chowdhury Humayun Kabir, Founder Member and Honorary Secretary, BMSRI, Chairman of the Governing Body of UAMC, and Head, Department of Surgery, BMC breathed his last on June 09, 2010 at BMCH. He was 71 after passing MBBS in 1962 and FRCS (Ed) in 1967, he exceeded his professional activities as Professor and Head, Dept. of Surgery, BSMMU (the then IPGM&R), Professor and Head, Dept. of Surgery, Sylhet and Mymensingh Medical College, Professor of Surgery, Dhaka Medical College, President, Society of Surgeons, Bangladesh and SAARC countries, Founder and President, Sandhani National Eye Donation Society, Founder and President, International Eye Bank, Sitting Member, Executive Committee, BM&DC, Managing Director, Metropolitan Medical Centre Ltd, and Founder of Bangladesh Medical and Dental Colleges- the first private Medical and Dental Colleges in Bangladesh. He is survived by his two daughters, one son and a host of relatives and well-wishers to mourn his death.
